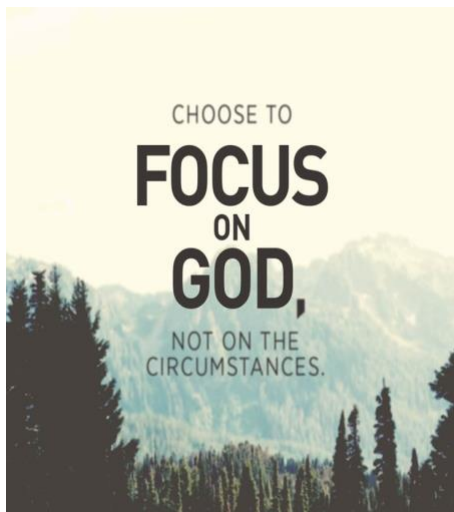
God, who in generous mercy
