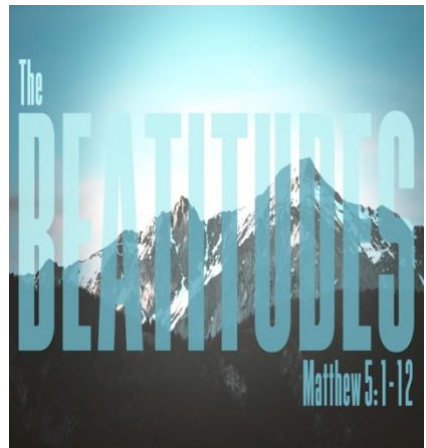
Today we are reflecting on the beatitudes and Kingdom living.
