Thank you for joining with us for our in-church and online services. This week we welcome Brother David Jardine to our 11am service.

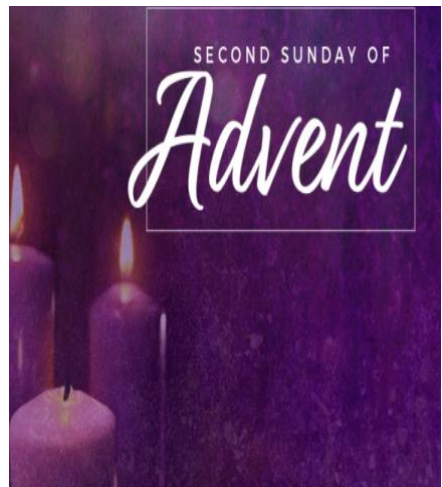
COLLECT OF THE DAY (Second Sunday of Advent)
