(Easter Day)

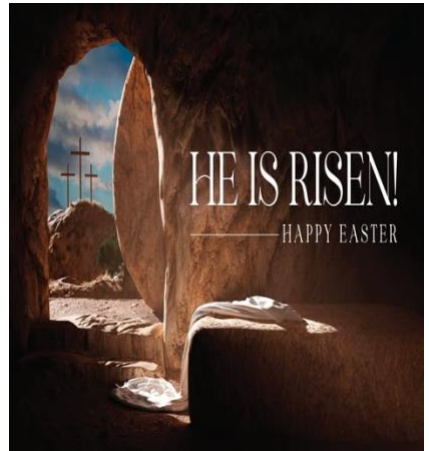
