Advent Services and Daily Reflections

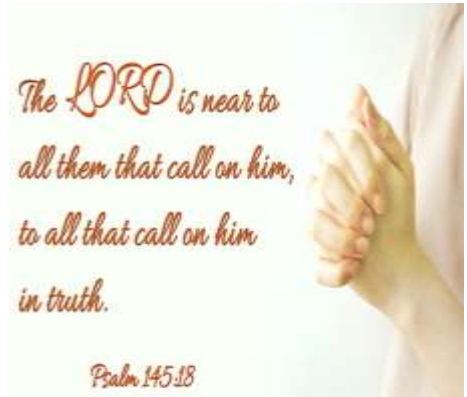
